ROCO Season Finale: World Premiere of Brad Sayles *Buffalo Bayou Suite*

In its season finale concert, April 17-18, 2010, River Oaks Chamber Orchestra (ROCO) will present the world premiere of the *Buffalo Bayou Suite*, an original composition by Brad Sayles for Endangered Species Media Project's film documentary about Buffalo Bayou.
